POTENTIAL HAZARD	ACTION REQUIRED
Hoses and sprinklers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reel hoses up in hose reel or store in shed
Electric extension cords	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If in use, ensure cable is safe and away from foot traffic
Overhanging plants, branches, hanging baskets.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tie up or prune bushes. Re-locate or raise baskets
Slips and falls Steps, slopes, wet areas	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Verbal warning, cordon off and signage
Pets	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Judge whether they are “public friendly” or need to be restrained
Water features, pools and ponds	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Signs. • Appropriate safety fencing. • Verbal warning.
Private areas.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lock house and other buildings. • Place “No Entry” signs in these areas. • Cordon off.
Machinery & tools / Chemicals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Keep in locked shed. Cordon Off. • Warning signs. Remove Keys.
Building/Landscaping Materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cordon Off • Signs
In case of fire	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Exits clearly signed, • Inform participants when they first arrive
Accident	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • First aid kit on hand
