- Opening hours for gardens are 10am to 4pm. Children free.
- Security of premises is the owner's responsibility.
- Entry fees and ticketing will be fully explained at the Gardeners' Gathering and in your Information Pack.
- There is an opportunity to raise money, perhaps for charity or a local organisation, by selling plants/crafts and refreshments. If selling refreshments you <u>must</u> contact the Public Health Unit at Baw Baw Shire on 5624 2411 to comply with the Food Safety Regulations. If you are raising money for charity or a local organisation there is no fee, if you are selling food for your own benefit there is a fee.
